#### African ccTLD overview

#### Different realities for different ccTLDs:

- Re-delegation
- Poor ccTLD infrastructure
- Undefined policy & governance model
- No local stakeholder buy-in
- Poor local uptake due to:
  - Restrictive pricing
  - Lack of government investment
  - Limited/no ccTLD marketing
- Limited/registry management skills



## Key interventions needed

### Different needs for different ccTLDs:

- Basic registry operations training
  - Fast-tracked approach is possible due to:
    - Readily available technologies
    - Existing ROC & ACRP programs (AfTLD with its partners)
    - ccTLD to ccTLD partnerships
- ccTLD business & institutional models
  - Again, fast-tracking is possible
- Security & robustness:
  - Anycast
  - DNSSec



## Deploying DNSSec in Africa

- Reality: ccTLDs must do 1<sup>st</sup> things first
  - Re-delegation, infrastructure development, technology, funding, etc
- Developed ccTLDs adopting a wait & see approach
  - Need for sharing lessons learnt
- DNSSec trust anchor issue
  - Some political concerns
- Structured DNSSec training program
  - ccTLD to ccTLD; AfTLD program
